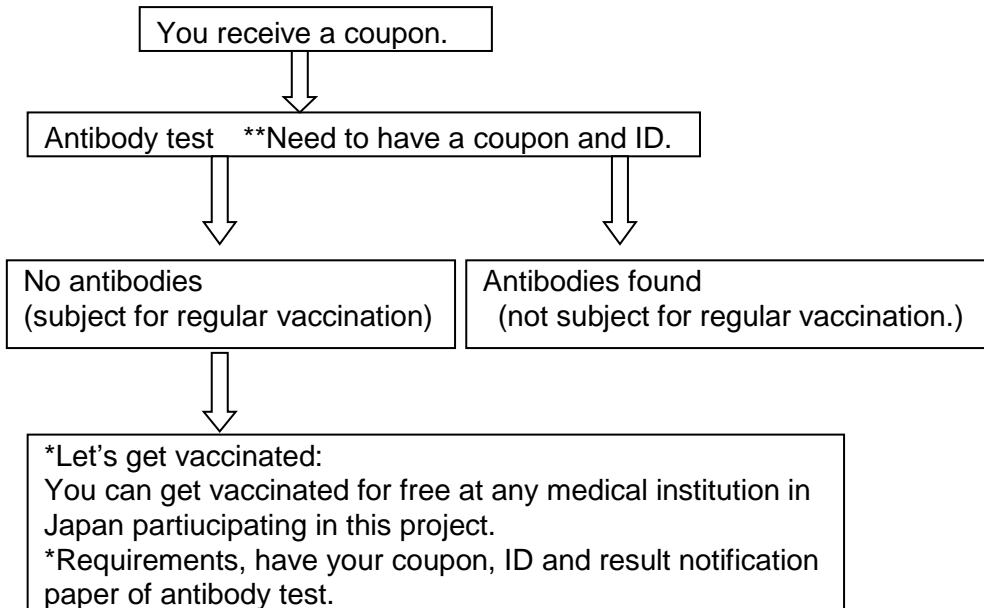

1. Start Urgent Rubella Measures.

- Let's prevent rubella disease with a vaccination for Men ages 40 to 57 years-old. This age group didn't have a chance to get vaccinated for rubella. Therefore they tend to have low antibody prevalence compared to other generations. From now to March 31st in 2022 for 3 years men in this age group can take an antibody test and get vaccinated for free.
- Procedure of antibody test and vaccination.



Once you show your coupon at the medical institution or medical examination venue, you can be tested for antibodies and get vaccinated.

2. Rabies Vaccinations for Your Dog(s), Needs to be Carried Out.

Rabies vaccinations every year, and registration are required of pet owners who have a dog (past 91 days after birth) by law.

- Things to bring: Dog card (dog handbook), Notification postcard
- Fee: 3,400 yen for Vaccinations per dog.
- Reminder:
 - 3,000 yen for registration per dog.
 - Prepare the correct amount of money so there is no need for change.
 - The program will be on even if it is rain.
 - Rabies vaccinations can be given at animal hospitals on days other than the scheduled day written on the postcard in the case of inconvenience or your dog's condition.
